Davidson Academy Online is an academically rigorous, synchronous online school for profoundly gifted middle and high school students living in the United States and Canada, with options for full-time or single-course enrollment.

LEVEL



Courses in humanities, math, and science for middle school students ages 9 to 13.

TIME



- Enroll in 1 or more a la carte courses
- Live sessions are Monday, Tuesday, or Wednesday at 3:00 pm or 4:15 pm PT
- 1 hour of live class time per course per week
- 4-6 hours of homework per course per week
- Courses run for a full academic year

APPLICATION



- Applications accepted November–January
- Qualifying achievement, aptitude, or IQ scores OR letter from school indicating student qualifies for gifted services AND recommendation required for non-DYS
- Qualifying criteria and recommendation waived for DYS
- Applications fee ranges from \$25 to \$100



- Applications accepted September–January
- Open to students in the US and Canada
- Qualifying achievement, aptitude, or IQ scores required
- Recommendation required
- \$100 fee (waived for NV residents)



- Applications accepted September–January
- Open to students in the US and Canada
- Qualifying achievement, aptitude, or IQ scores required
- 3 recommendations required
- \$100 fee (waived for NV residents)

ASSESSMENT



- All DYS applicants are assessed for readiness
- Qualified non-DYS applicants are assessed

TUITION



- \$1,200 per course
- \$250 deposit due after acceptance
- \$475 due each semester
- Tuition due beginning August 1
